UNCOPUOS

- The Report could be made available for information to delegations as a Conference Room Paper (CRP) at the UNCOPUOS Scientific and Technical Subcommittee and the Legal Subcommittee in 2021
- This would have several advantages, such as:
 - Raise awareness among UNCOPUOS delegates and increase their knowledge about the topic
 - The Report would be **officially recorded in the UN documentation system** and can easily be retrieved at any time
- An open question is who will introduce and possibly present the CRP: SMPAG, UNOOSA, a member state (e.g. Germany DLR), an observer (e.g. ESA)?



International Conferences

- The Report could be presented at international conferences such as:
 - Planetary Defense Conference (April 2021)
 - International Astronautical Congress (October 2021)
 - COSPAR Assembly (January 2021)
- This could highlight the work of the SMPAG Legal Working Group and raise awareness with regard to legal aspects of planetary defence
- Members of the SMPAG LWG could submit abstracts
