EXERCISE TASKS

Exercise tasks



- The first sprint will focus on the national organisation and coordination and on defining the lists of tasks to be performed in response to a real threat scenario.
- To harmonise the national (SMPAG-level) efforts into a SMPAG coordinated action this must be organised at communication level, technical level, decision level. The second sprint will focus on discussing how the coordination is done among different SMPAG delegations.
- The third sprint will deal with communication and coordination issues within SMPAG.



Sprint 2/3

- Task 4
 - Integrate the task lists defined by each SMPAG member [Task 1] in the SMPAG list [Task 4]
 - Compare and discuss the entities involved at national (SMPAG-member) level for the completion and coordination of these tasks at national (SMPAG-member) level [Task 2] and define the delegation involved in the SMPAG list of tasks [Task 4]
 - Compare and discuss the internal (SMPAG-member) procedure for performing and advancing the tasks (already in place or desired) identified at Task 1 at national (SMPAG-member) level [Task 3] and define the procedure for performing them internationally SMPAG list [Task 4]
 - For each Task or group of Tasks
 - define Working Groups (WG), WG leader and deputy
 - define participating delegations and activities
 - define timeline
 - SMPAG common coordination plan

Sprint 2/3

- Task 5
 - Data for exchange of information
 - Format of data, e.g. orbits, spacecraft design, orbit determination, analyses
 - Architecture support for sharing data,
 - E.g. ESA or NASA SharePoint, UN?
 - Accesses, data etc.



- The SMPAG NEO threat exercise will be performed
 - through monthly telecons among participating SMPAG members and
 - through work at the international SMPAG-member level work
 - Telecon slot: 3rd Thu of each month starting from Oct 2023 at 12pm UTC
 - First meeting Thu 19 Oct 12 pm UTC



- The output of the exercise will be a final report containing all the output of Sprint 2/3 on SMPAG collaboration and sprint 3/3 on SMPAG coordination and communication.
- The results of the analysis and the collective analysis of each delegation will be coordinated in a unique presentation at SMPAG meeting in Feb 2024.
- The resulting report and presentation could form a conference paper for information under NEO agenda item of the Scientific and Technical Subcommittee of COPUOS.




