# Introduction



- Survey conducted in 2011
- Web form, open for 5 weeks: 14/11/2011 19/12/2011
- Announced via email to archives users that had been active within the last five years (just over 4500 users).
- Was redistributed by some missions to their own lists of users


- Total number of responses to the survey was 385 -> a response rate of approximately 8.4%.
- Approximately ten times more satisfied users than dissatisfied users.
- Received a lot of useful feedback, e.g. at the time all archives were Java based, and we received many comments on this (Appendix B).

## Results: Caveat




- We noticed a pattern appearing in the answers of questions 1 to 3 because the survey did not offer the option of 'never' or 'not applicable'
- Probably the questions, as they were written, were a bit ambiguous
- We believe some people felt obliged to select all the Archives in questions 1 and 2, and mark the options 'less than once a year' and 'neutral' respectively for Archives they never use.
- This led to a large peak in the 'less than once a year' responses






# How satisfied are you with the ESAC Science Archives?




# How often do you use one of the Science Archives?






#### Which type of access interface do you use?




#### For which activities do you use the Archives?

# Conclusions



- Don't expect a large number of people responding to the call and filling out the survey. 10% is very good.
- Therefore, distribute the survey as widely as possible to as many users as possible.
- Keep the survey short, or have only a few compulsory questions -> very little time needed to fill it out.
- Add options such as 'not applicable', 'never' etc.
- Feedback from the 'open text' questions were also very useful.
